## Aging with Attitude Regional Expo 2018: A Community Partnership Impacting Older Adults



**Purpose** The Aging with Attitude Regional Expo promotes positive attitudes about aging and educates older Kansans on issues that support physical, mental, and financial health.

**The Situation** According to the U.S. Census Bureau, 19.3% of Americans' and 19.5% of Kansans are age 60+.<sup>2</sup> The population of the nation and of the state will grow older as the Baby Boomer generation moves into later life. As older adults are more likely to experience disability and chronic diseases, this demographic shift will have significant consequences in terms of health and wellness of the population.

What We Did K-State Extension family and consumer sciences professionals and key community partners planned and hosted the Aging with Attitude Regional Expo in Iola, Kansas on April 27, 2018. The annual event included 12 educational sessions and 25 resource exhibits. The Expo supports on-going local program priorities focused on health and community vitality. There were over 160 people from 11 southeast Kansas counties involved.

**Outcomes** Program post surveys from 68% of the participants indicated the following:

- 87% learned something new.
- 84% indicated they were planning to change something in their lives.
- 93% stated they had more positive feelings toward the topic of aging.
- 84% indicated they understood there were proactive steps they could take that may influence how they age.
- 84% understood there are lifestyle changes they could make that may improve or maintain their overall health and wellness.
- 84% stated they now know where to go to find more health or wellness related information.

A four month follow-up phone survey of 22 participants (21%) indicated that as a result of attending the expo:

- 91% said they have a better understanding of aging issues today.
- 68% stated they had taken action or changed something in their life.
- 18% indicated they had made contact with a vendor following the Expo resource fair.
- 32% took steps to downsize or declutter their living space.
- 32% made dietary changes and/or are eating healthier.
